The feedback forms were administered to stakeholders via a structured questionnaire tailored to their specific roles and perspectives:

- 1. **For students**: This questionnaire addressed curriculum and learning-related aspects such as quality, competence, skills, and professionalism. It also included considerations regarding the delivery of the curriculum by teachers.
- 2. For teachers: Feedback focused on the suitability of courses, outcomes of the curriculum, relationship with course content and reference materials, availability of resources, evaluation methods, and curriculum delivery.
- 3. **For employers**: The questionnaire addressed general communication skills, problemsolving abilities, teamwork, creativity, organizational skills, and the integration of technology learned through the curriculum.
- For alumni: Feedback sought responses regarding the adequacy of the curriculum, sufficiency of syllabus content based on current professional standards, and the effectiveness of the curriculum in fostering self-directed learning and problemsolving.
- 5. For Parents: Recognizing their pivotal role in their children's future, the questionnaire aimed to gather feedback from parents to evaluate service provision and ensure the delivery of excellent service to students.

1) Students Feedback

Student feedback is paramount in higher education systems, as students are the most critical stakeholders. Their active involvement in both internal and external quality assurance processes is essential. Throughout the assessment period, the college gathered feedback offline from both undergraduate and postgraduate students. Utilizing a distinctive four-point scale feedback questionnaire focused on the curriculum, the college sought to gather valuable insights into student perspectives.
